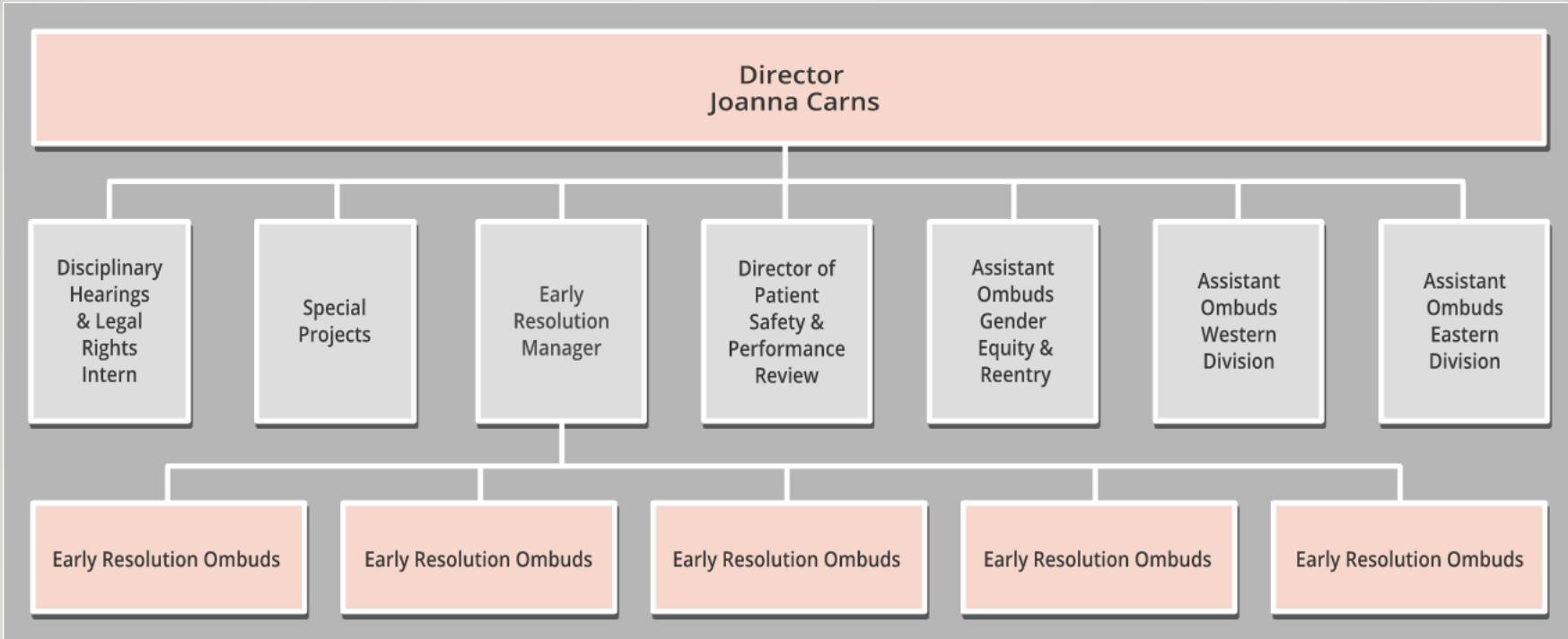

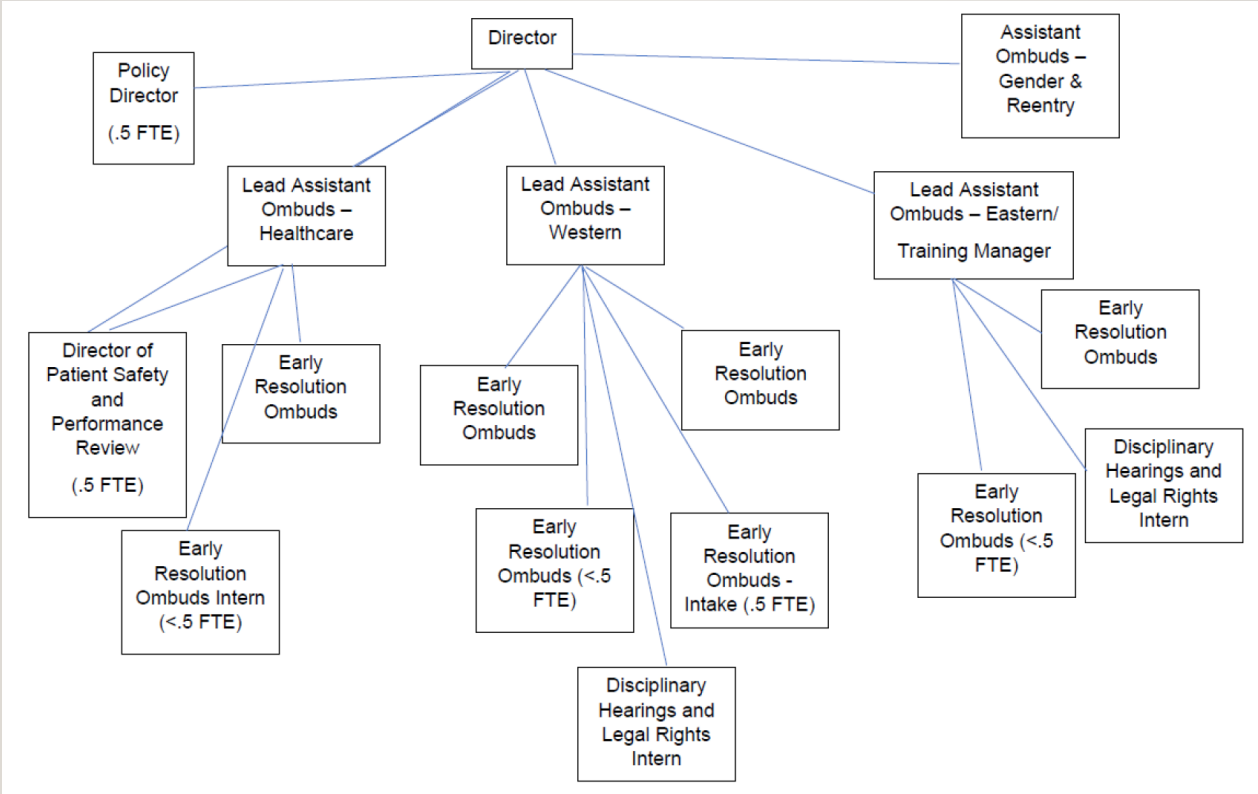
MONTHLY OUTCOME REPORTS

- As of Sept 1, 2020, all cases opened by OCO are considered “investigations” for the purposes of the RCW, which require a public report with a decision on each complaint. The public report is being fulfilled through our monthly outcome reports that provide an anonymous synopsis of every case closed in the prior month.
